
CREAMARE project is progressing very well, achieving a lot of success both on cooperation and on the production of the serious game. Check out this newsletter and see our achievements and future plans.



Residency program in Cosenza (Italy)

With six creative professionals

From 2nd to 7th October 2023, project's partners welcomed the selected creative professionals (*Lea Novaković* - sound designer, *Renato Malerba*, *Federico Mele*, *Roberto Vergine* - level designers, and *Rea Budic*, *Mauro Forte* - 3D artists) and involved them in co-design activities for the development of the **CREAMARE Serious Game**, which focused on the protection of Underwater Cultural Heritage and on Ocean Literacy. During the residency week, the creatives worked in cooperation with experts and professionals from the CREAMARE Team to develop the blueprint of this amazing game, which will be completed in the next few months.



Training course in Tremiti Islands (Italy): from 12th to 16th June 2023, the first underwater photogrammetry course addressed to cultural professionals was organized; teachers from 3D Research alternated lectures focused on digital technologies for Underwater Cultural Heritage enhancement and practical diving sessions on the wreck ruins of the Steamship Lombardo, that sank in 1864. A crew from Euronews lead by Denis Loctier visited the CREAMARE team to document the progress of the project.

Training course in Algeciras Bay (Spain): in an intensive week of training, which took place from 6th to 10th November 2023, the CREAMARE team had the privilege of sharing the innovative project approach to underwater surveying with an international group of underwater archaeologists and operators. Participants learned the entire workflow, from image acquisition to the reconstruction of 3D models and the accurate restoration of the objects' original colors. In addition, there were classes at the University of Cádiz, where students explored the concepts of photography and underwater surveying for photogrammetry.
